The Energy Innovation Lab (EIL) is a small business incubator designed to empower energy entrepreneurs whose product or service ideas have the potential to reimagine the future of the energy industry, increase energy efficiency and affordability, and meet the evolving energy needs for Philadelphia residents, underserved communities, and businesses.

## **SELECTION PROCESS**

A knowledgeable panel of judges will oversee a two-round selection process during which applicants' proposals will be evaluated and ranked based on viability and alignment with PGW's mission of enhancing the quality of life for all by delivering safe, reliable, affordable energy in an environmentally responsible way.

The volunteer judges are representatives from Philadelphia's leading energy, innovation, and start-up development organizations, including: The City of Philadelphia, Comcast, Benjamin Franklin Technology Partners, NextFab, PGW, and Temple University.

## **BUILD A CLEAN ENERGY FUTURE**

Selected Energy Innovation Lab energy entrepreneur(s) will receive comprehensive SBDC entrepreneurship support services and PGW energy industry expert mentoring for the duration of the two-year program, as well as a stipend of up to \$30,000.

The EIL is actively seeking applicants developing new technologies, applications, business models, software, or services addressing (1) Energy Efficiency and Conservation; (2) Greenhouse Gas (GHG) Emission Reduction; (3) Energy Affordability and Access. As a business incubator, the EIL is targeting Solutions that are beyond the proof-of-concept stage and moving to product development, in order to benefit from the EIL program's access to interactions with potential customers for refining existing business models and targeted markets.
